

RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS OF 2014

Setting its mission as to create, share, and apply knowledge in the service of society, and vision to become an entrepreneurial research university, Özyeğin University (ÖzÜ), since its foundation in 2007, has been focusing on intense research as well as improving and disseminating knowledge. Similar to former years, in 2014, ÖzÜ strived to align its research efforts with its missions and vision, and had a steady upward trend for both number of projects carried out and volume of research fund received. ÖzÜ managed to reach over 36 million TL research volume in total that constitutes an increase of 100% comparing last year's performance.

EU for the international research projects and TÜBİTAK for the national research projects became the largest funding agencies in ÖzÜ research portfolio. As a noteworthy highlight of 2014, the volume of industry sponsored projects under university-industry cooperation scheme increased sharply, and reached to 2 million TL in 2014. This, literally, is the proof of the growing reputation and recognition of ÖzÜ among industry and private sector.

Of course, the most of the credit for such performance and success goes to faculty members of ÖzÜ. Without their motivation, research-oriented approaches and hard work, it was impossible to have a successful year. At its second year, TTO has been an indispensable part of the research conducted at ÖzÜ, and the main drive behind such performance.

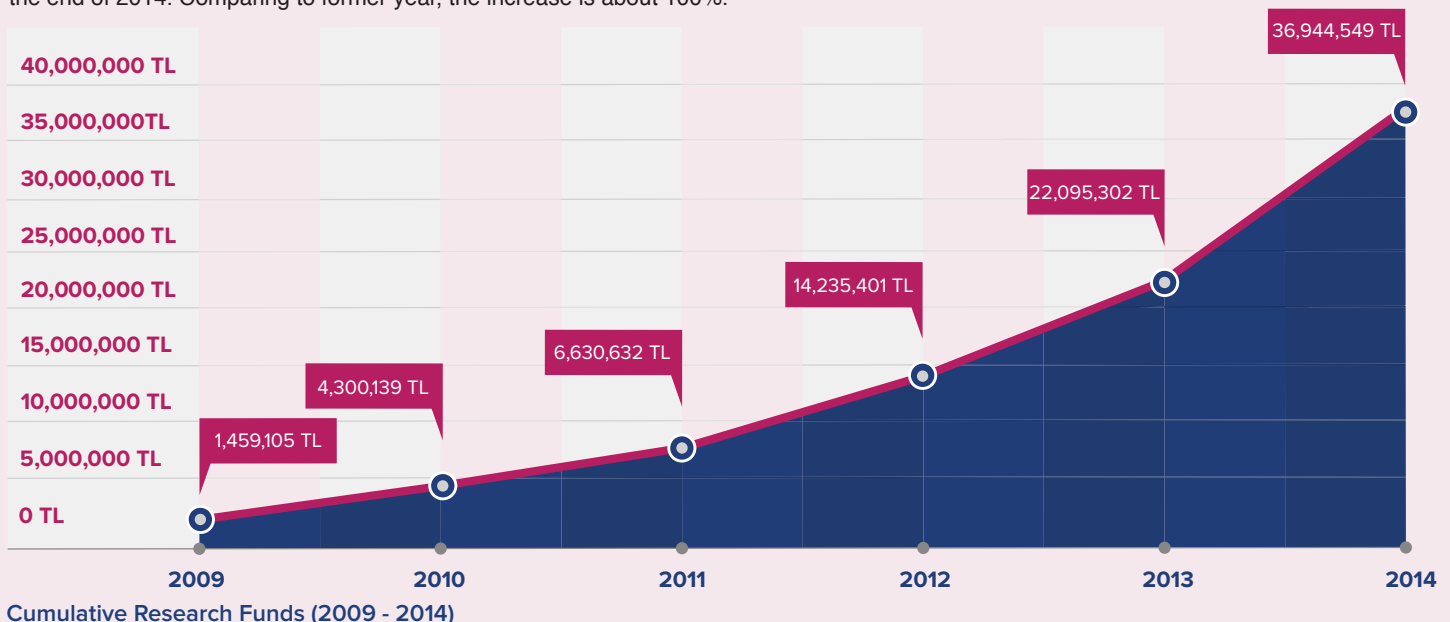
We are very excited to welcome 2015 to have a better year and to sustain the rising trend that has been continuing since the foundation of our university.

SPONSORED RESEARCH PERFORMANCE OVERVIEW

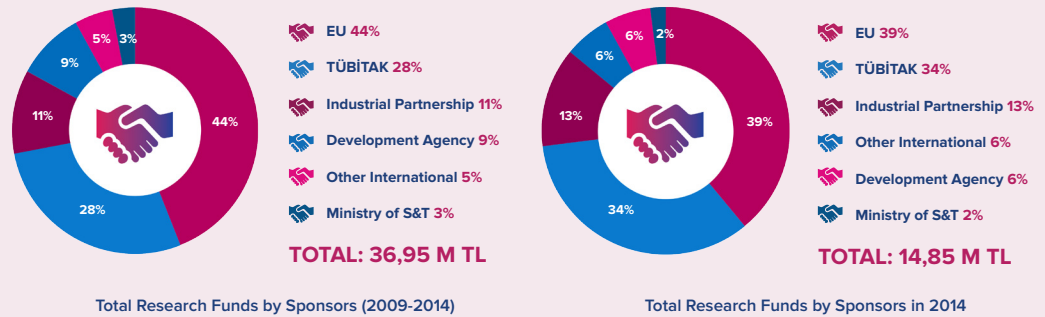
The figure below clearly shows that since 2009, ÖzÜ managed to sustain a steady upward trend in cumulating research funds. By the year 2009, the total volume of research funds accumulated by ÖzÜ was approximately 1,5 million TL whereas this reached over 36 million TL at the end of 2014. Comparing to former year, the increase is about 100%.

EU remained the biggest sponsor for the research conducted at ÖzÜ for the last 5 years. Of the funds ÖzÜ benefited between 2009 and 2014, 44% was provided by the EU, mostly FP7 Program. TÜBİTAK comes second after the EU, yet it is the biggest national funding agency for ÖzÜ research. As a noteworthy detail, the national and international funds are at balance; almost half of the funds come from international funding agencies (44% the EU, 5% Other International) whereas the other half was provided by National Agencies (28% TÜBİTAK, 11% Industrial Partnership, 9% Development Agency, and 3% Ministry of Science, Technology and Industry).

For the recent fiscal year (2014), ÖzÜ received a total of almost 15 million TL. Similar to former five years, the EU has still been the larger supporter for research at ÖzÜ with a share of 39% at the total research fund received by ÖzÜ. TÜBİTAK has been the second after the EU, and the share of TÜBİTAK has been 34% in 2014. In terms of the origin of the funding agencies, more than half of the funds received (57%) have come from national agencies such as TÜBİTAK, İSTKA (İstanbul Development Agencies), and Ministry of Science, Industry, and Technology.

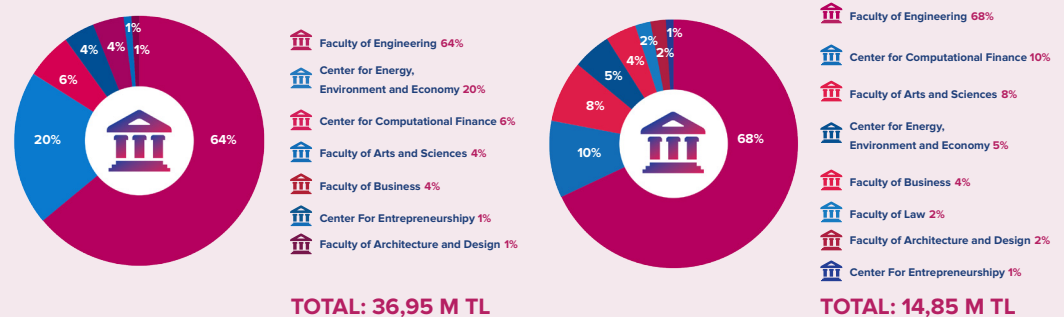


Total Research Funds by Sponsors (2009-2014)

ÖzÜ TOTAL RESEARCH FUNDS BY FACULTY

Faculty of Engineering has been the leading academic unit at ÖzÜ in terms of research. Between 2009-2014, 64% of the funds received by ÖzÜ was achieved by the Faculty of Engineering. Moreover, research centers at ÖzÜ whose missions are to embody interdisciplinary approach, and to bring together faculty members, students, and stakeholders from public and private sectors so as to solve real-life problems, play a very vital role at ÖzÜ research Scene. The Center for Energy, Environment and Economy (CEEE), Center for Computational Finance (CCF), and Center for Entrepreneurship (CE) performed, as they were faculties. They have been continuing



Total Research Funds by Faculty (2009-2014)

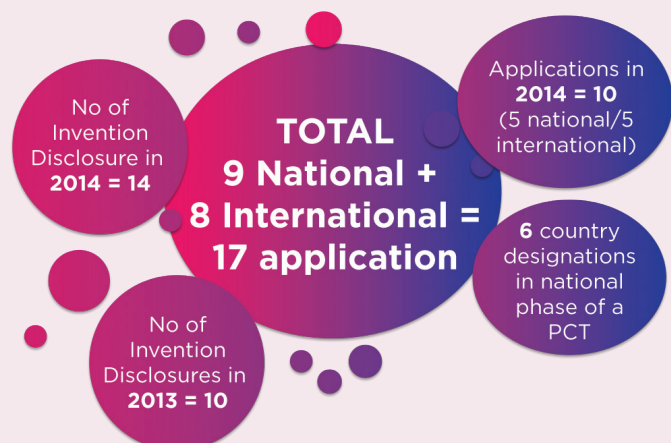
Total Research Funds by Faculty in 2014

to contribute to the research performance of ÖzÜ. Center for Energy, Environment and Economy has been second and Center of Computational Finance has been third to receive funding after the Faculty of Engineering.

In 2014, the Faculty of Engineering constitutes almost 70% of the total research fund received by ÖzÜ faculty. However, what was significant especially for 2014 that Faculty of Social Sciences dramatically increased number and hence volume of its research projects. Due to new TÜBİTAK Projects throughout the years, the Faculty of Social Sciences (Arts and Sciences) has been increasing its performance and eventually in 2014 their share at the total research funds received by ÖzÜ reached to 8%. The "Research Centers" have been continuing to play very significant roles at research conducted at ÖzÜ, and totally, canter's share has become 15% in 2014.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY MANAGEMENT IN 2014

New technologies invented and developed at ÖzÜ include innovations in nanotechnology, lighting technologies (LED systems and protein-based LED systems), chemical mechanical, nano-texturing, robotics, green technology applications, thermoelectric, thermal cogeneration, medical devices and diagnostics. Currently, ÖzÜ owns 9 national (TPE) and 8 international patent applications alongside 6 country designations of one of the PCT applications.





SUCCESS STORIES 2014

The First European Research Council (ERC) Grants

Asst. Prof. Dr. Sedat Nizamoğlu, Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering faculty member, has been qualified for the European Research Council's (ERC) Starting Grant. Dr. Nizamoğlu will be using the funding provided by the council for 5 years for his research project titled "Novel Nanoengineered Optoelectronic Biointerfaces". Dr. Nizamoğlu's grant is the first ERC Starting grant received by ÖZÜ and the 7th ERC grant in Turkey.

The First Jean Monnet Grants

Our faculty members, Asst. Prof. Dr. Ozan Turhan and Asst. Prof. Dr. Margarite Helena Zoetewij-Turhan won the first two Jean Monnet Grants of ÖZÜ.

Asst. Prof. Dr. Zoetewij-Turhan's project ("Interdisciplinary lunchbox seminar on EU integration: An introduction to the EU, EU law and policies for university students and staff) aims to provide academicians and students information about Turkey's integration into the EU, and how a prospective membership is likely to change our daily lives socially, individually, politically, financially, and legally through a multi-disciplinary approach.

Asst. Prof. Dr. Turhan's project ("Continuing Education of the Turkish Bar: the EU, EU law and its practical implications for the Turkish Legal Service Sector") aims to train more than 400 attorneys from 10 different Bar Associations all around Turkey about the possible impacts of the EU Law on Turkish Legal Service Sector and the free movement of attorneys at the EU Law.

The First ARTEMIS Project in Turkey

EU's foremost research program in "Embedded Systems", ARTEMIS (<http://www.artemis-ju.eu>), and TÜBİTAK jointly funded a 3-year project at ÖZÜ with an approximate budget of 500,000TL. Assoc. Prof. Dr. H. Fatih Uğurdağ, faculty member of Electrical & Electronics Engineering Department will be the coordinator of the project entitled as "ALMARVI: Algorithms, Design Methods, and Many-Core Execution Platform for Low-Power Massive Data-Rate Video and Image Processing". The total budget of the project is approximately 48 million TL and consortium has 16 partners, including Philips-Netherlands, Nokia-Finland, and Aselsan-Turkey. This project happens to be the first academic ARTEMIS project in Turkey.

ÖZÜ Received A New Grant From ISTKA (Istanbul Development Agency)

Özyeğin University Center for Computational Finance received another grant from ISTKA (Istanbul Development Agency) Financial Support Program of 2014. Assist. Prof. Dr. Emrah Şener, the director of the Center for Computational Finance, will be the coordinator of the project entitled as "Systemic Risk Software". The main purpose of the project is to detect and minimize systemic risk stated in the Strategy and Action Plan for Istanbul International Financial Center, to establish "National Systemic Risk Software and Credit Rating Platform" and to increase transparency in finance market via the reliable infrastructure of the software. The duration of the project is 12 months and the total ÖZÜ budget is 910.000 TL.

ÖZÜ TTO's Mentorship for Sakarya University TTO as 2014 TÜBİTAK 1513 Grant Awardee

ÖZÜ TTO provided mentorship for writing Sakarya University TTO's proposal for TÜBİTAK 1513 TTO Grant Program in 2014 and Sakarya University is selected as new TTOs.

In 2014, only 5 TTO's are awarded a funding of 1 million TL/year up to 10 years upon successful annual evaluation by TÜBİTAK.

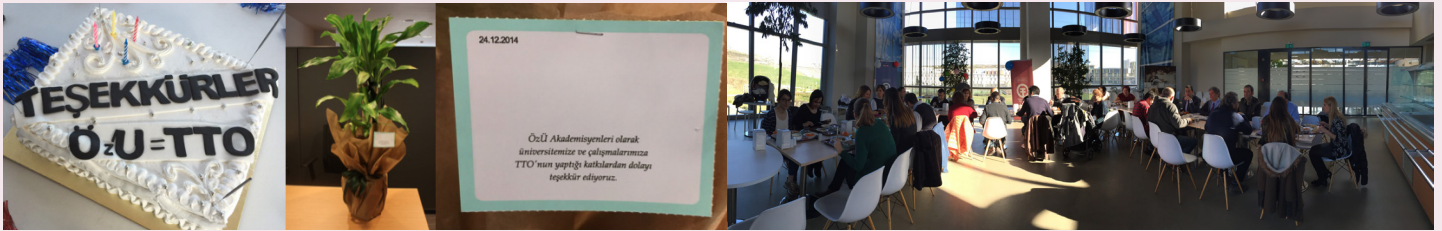
